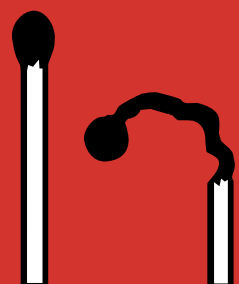

This education programme is based upon the Department For Communities and Local Government's Fire Safety Education Programme.

You are invited to deliver aspects of the education pack; these safety messages can then be reinforced by a visit at a later date by GFRS.

GFRS have 5 safety aims and objectives, which are covered by the activities in the education pack. These aims are the same throughout all the education packs but focus on age related issues.

Before delivering any of the lessons you need to be aware of any children who have experienced a fire, a sensitive approach should be taken.

It is possible that younger children may become unduly worried about the dangers of fire. It is therefore important that you remind children at the end of each lesson that house fires are rare and re-enforce how they can keep safe.

GFRS aim to interact with every child and young person in the County at least once in each Key Stage. During Key Stage 2, we encourage this interaction to be Year 5.
