My route

I get to the end of my road after around 200 meters and turn right. I pass St John's Church on my right that has a large tower with a clock on. After about 50 meters I get to a large roundabout and take the second exit. I carry on going straight on with the river on my right and canal on my left. On this road I pass through 3 sets of traffic lights. At Sainsbury's I turn right and head up the hill. The hill leads me up onto the common where the cows are often roaming freely. At the next cross roads I turn left and pass the pub and bus stop. I carry on over the cattle grid and down the hill for approximately 5 kilometres. I pass the butchers, chemist and newsagents as I drive through the village. I take the second exit on the right onto Friars Road and have reached my destination.
