

# Barbeque

# Candle

- Some candles smell nice.
- Candles can burn and hurt you.
  - Never touch candles.



# Cigarette

- A cigarette is **hot**.
- Some grown ups smoke cigarettes, you should never smoke cigarettes, they can make you poorly.
- You must never touch cigarettes, matches, lighters or ashtrays.
- They could burn you or start a fire.



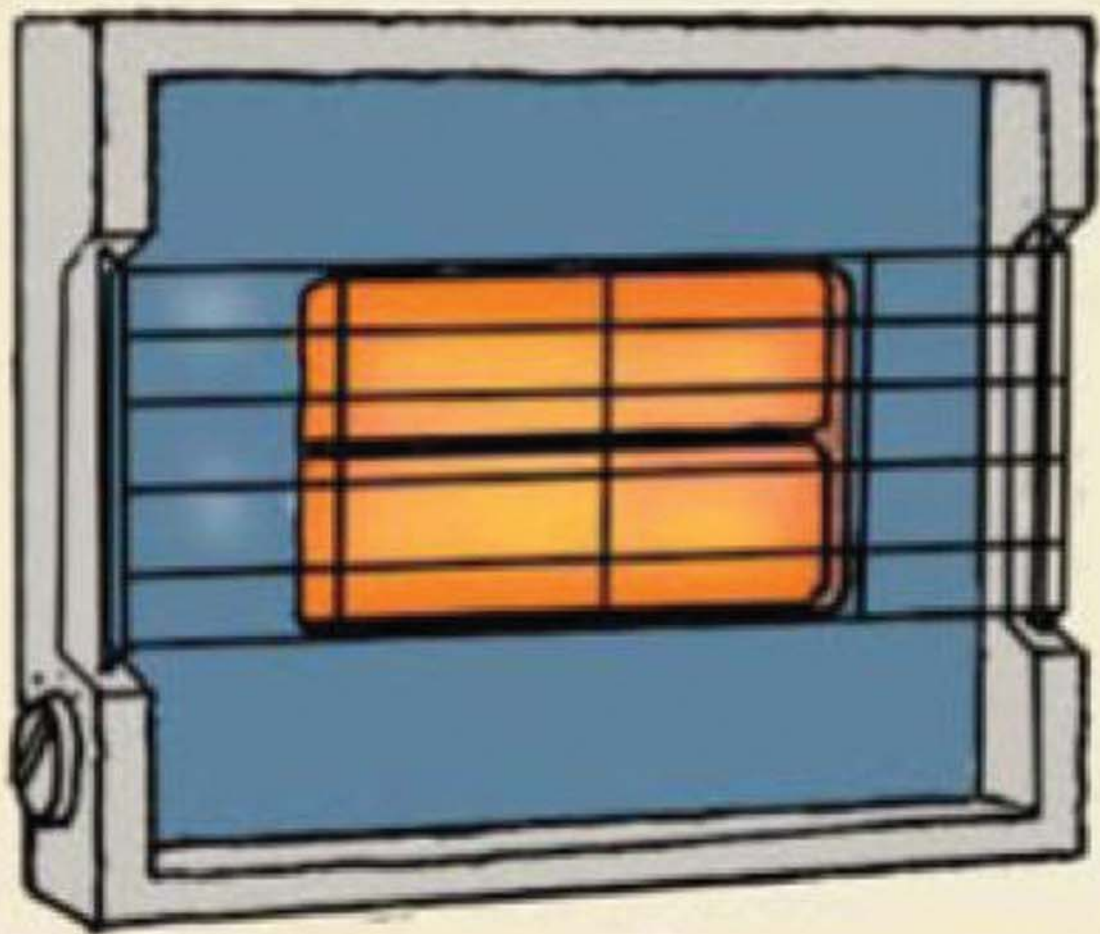
# Cold Drink

- Keep your kitchen safe by keeping your toys out of the kitchen.



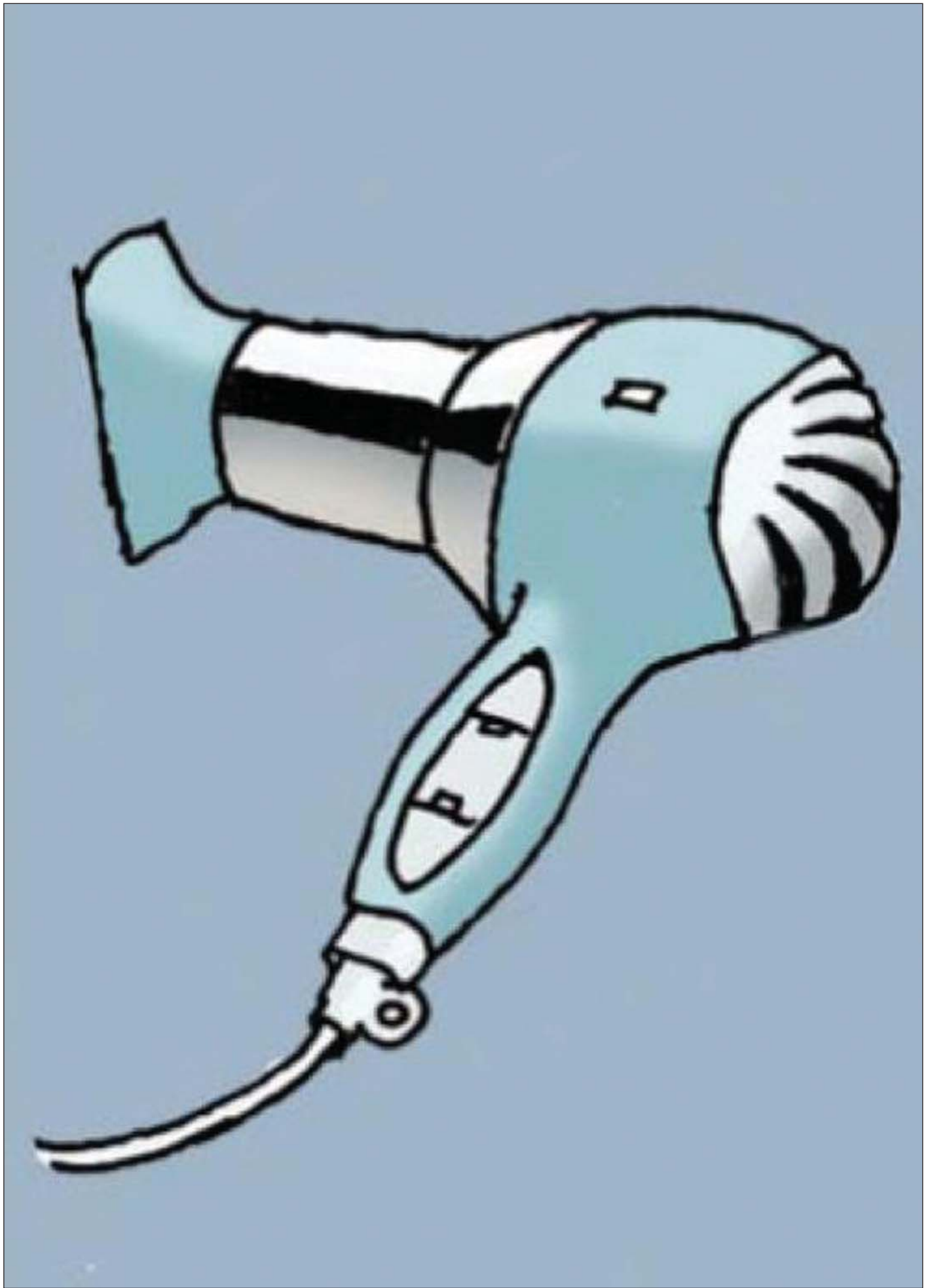
# Electric Fire

- When it is on the electric fire is **hot**.
- The electric fire warms us in the winter.
- Do not touch the fire it could burn you.
- Do not put clothes or toys too close to the fire as they could catch fire.
- Only a grown up should touch the fire.



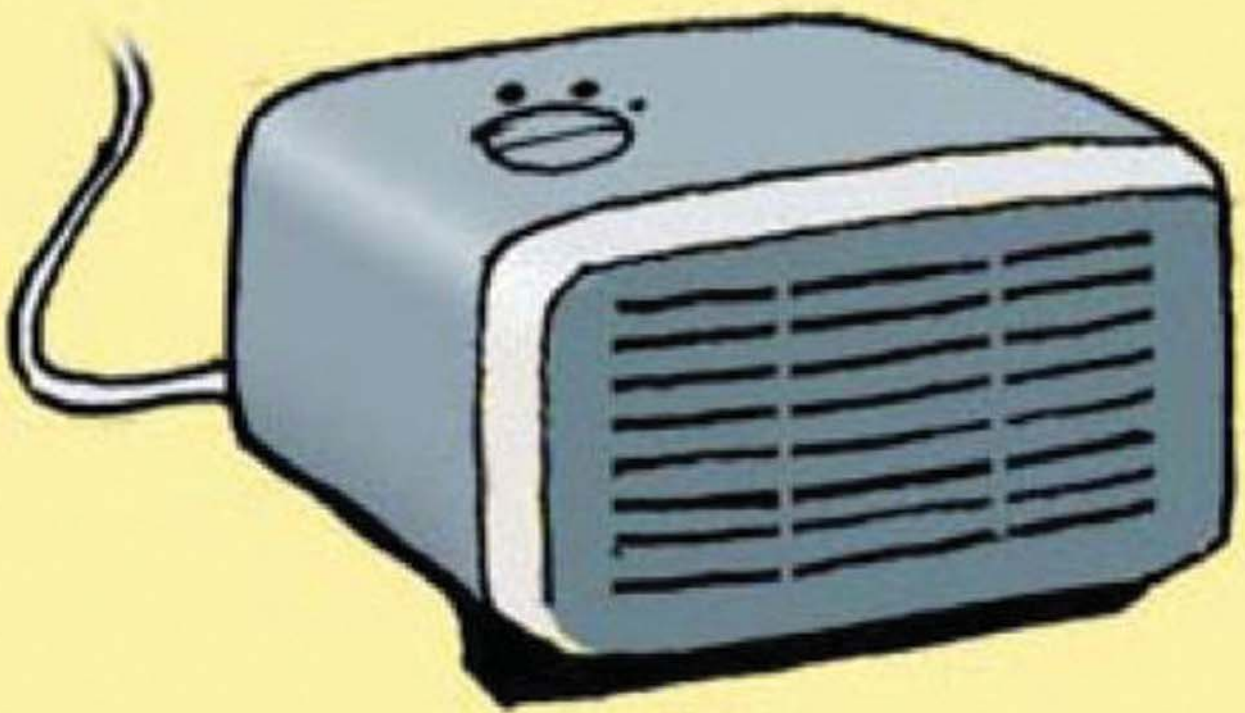
# Fridge

- It is used to store food to keep it fresh.



# Hairdryer

- When it is being used the hairdryer is **hot**.
  - It is used to dry hair.
- A hairdryer could burn you if you touched it when it was hot.
- Take care not to cover or put the hairdryer down on material when it has been on as it will still be hot and could start a fire.

- Only a grown up should touch the heater.



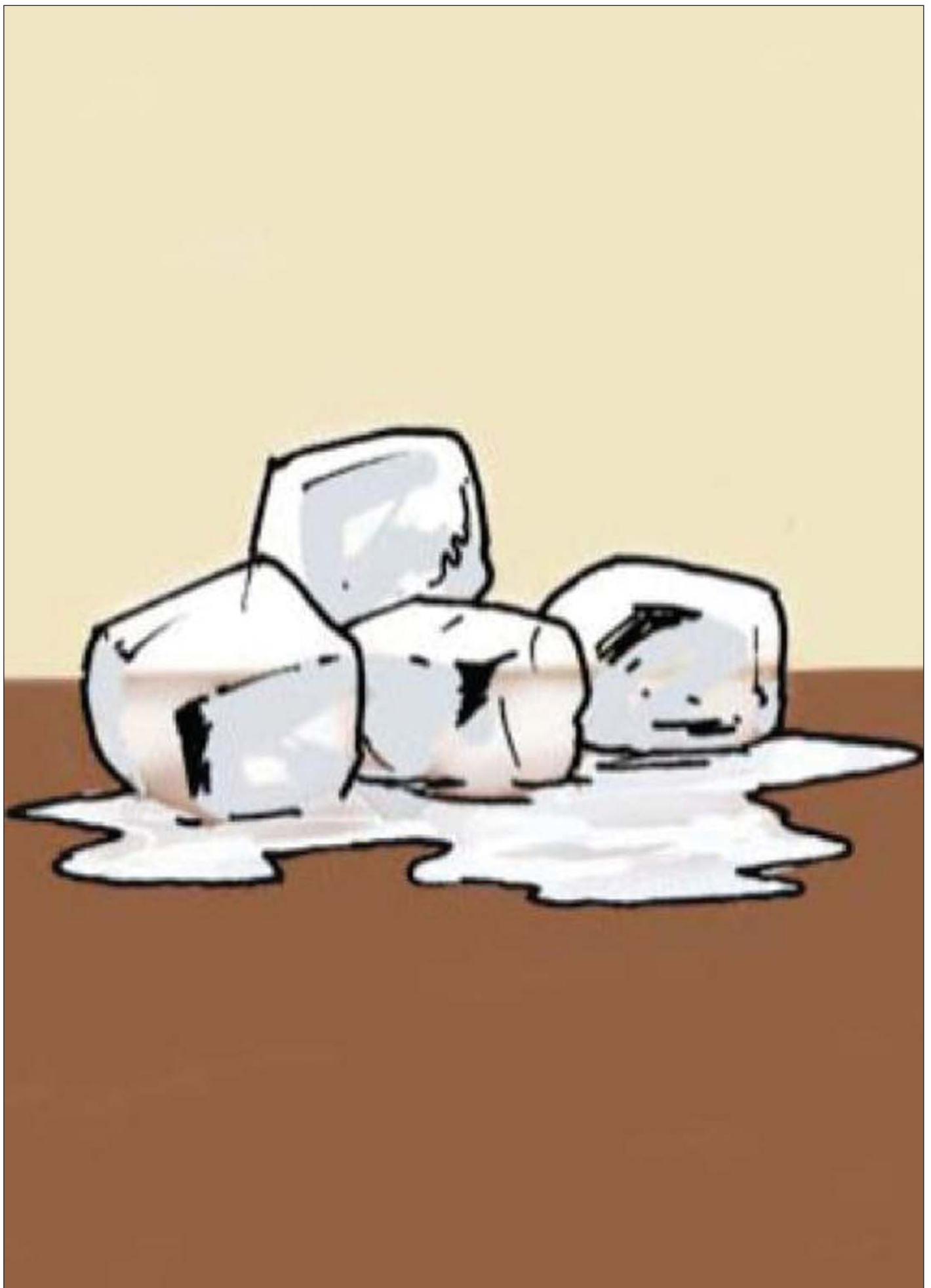
# Ice Cream

- Be careful near irons as they can burn.



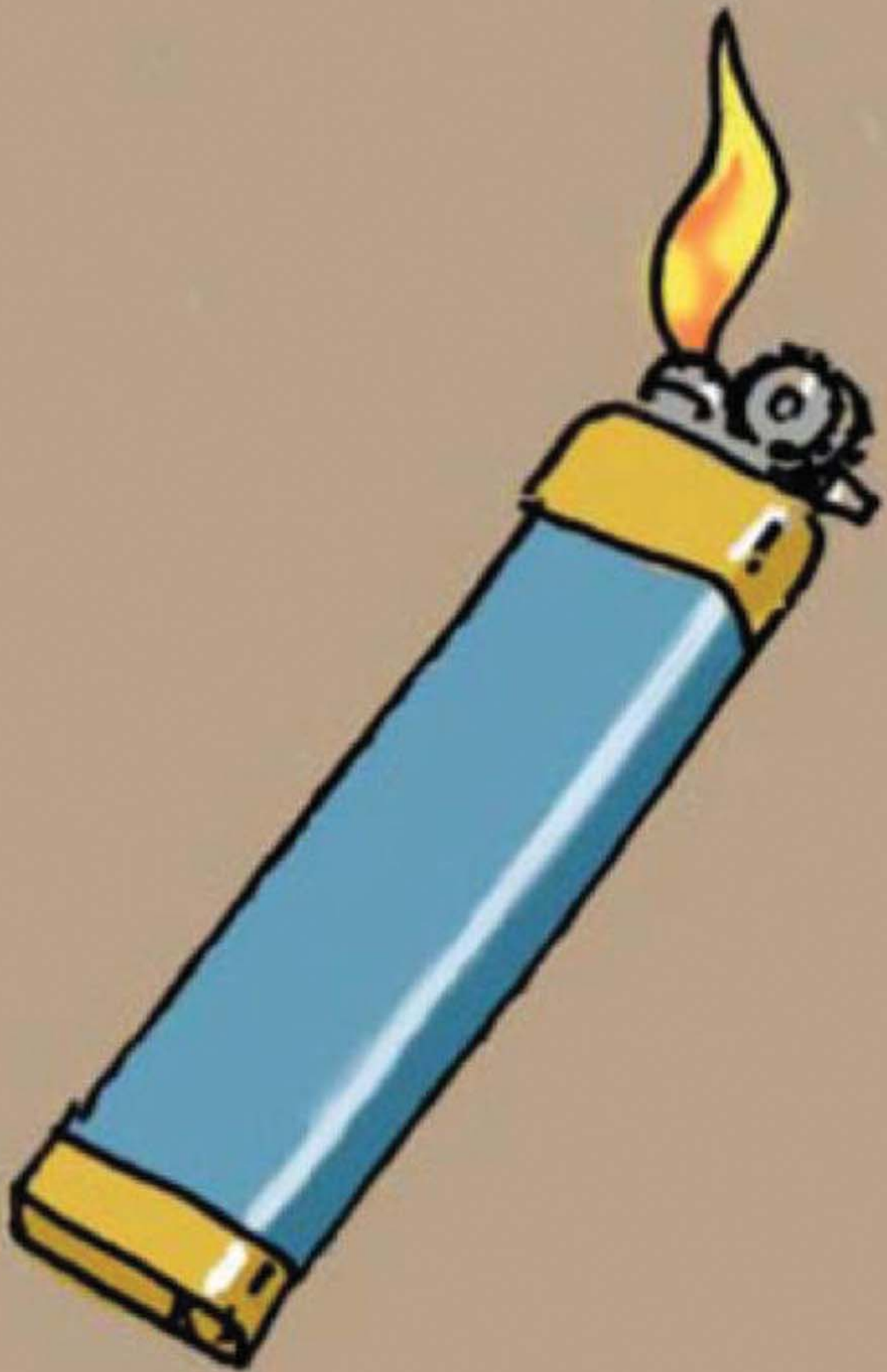
# Kettle

- Be careful near kettles as hot water can scald.



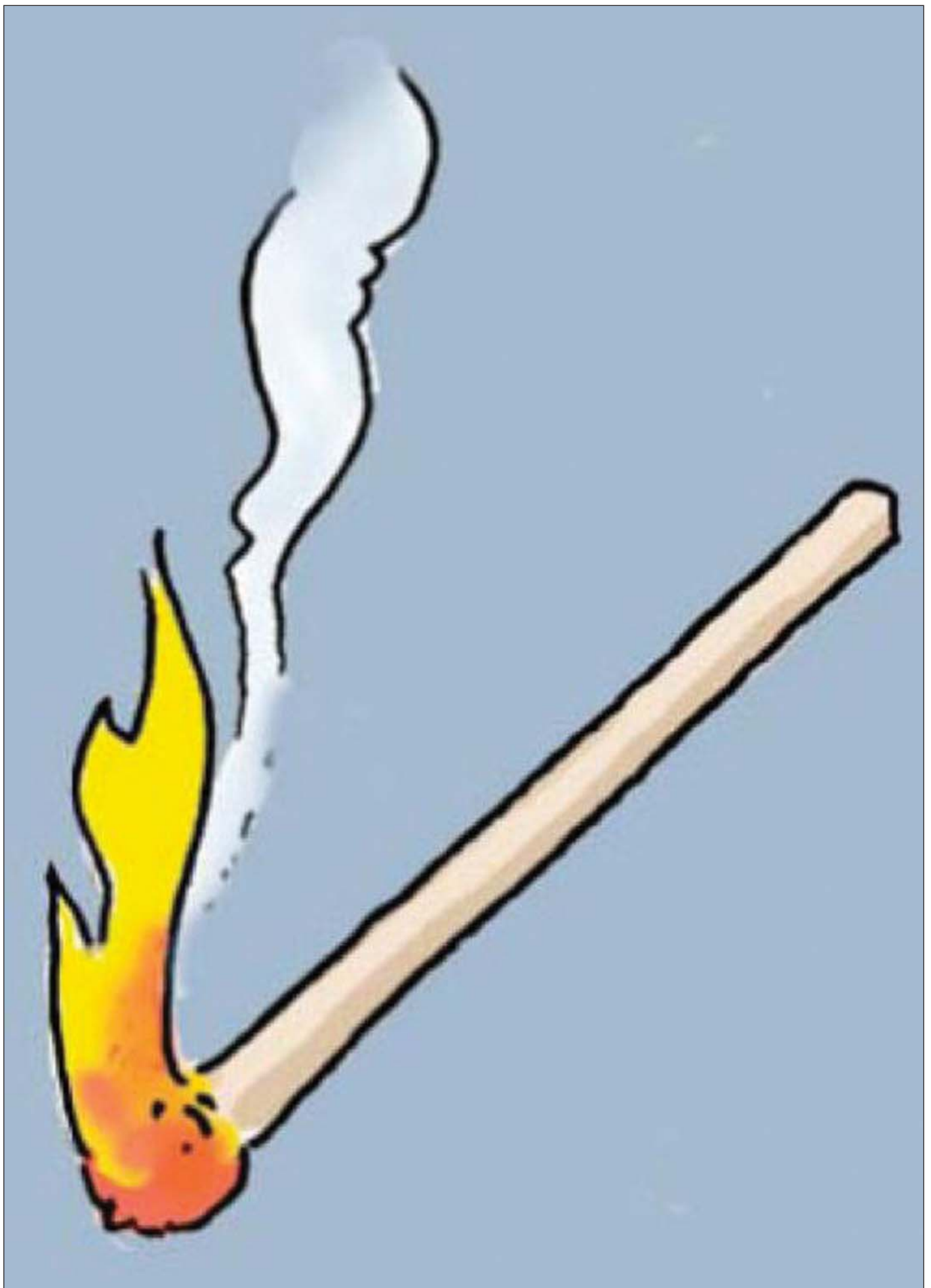
# Lamp

  - Grown ups use lighters to light cigarettes, gas cookers and candles.



# Match

- The match is **hot**.
- It makes a flame which can burn you or set fires.
- If you see matches, do not touch it.
  - Grown ups use matches to light cigarettes, gas cookers and candles.



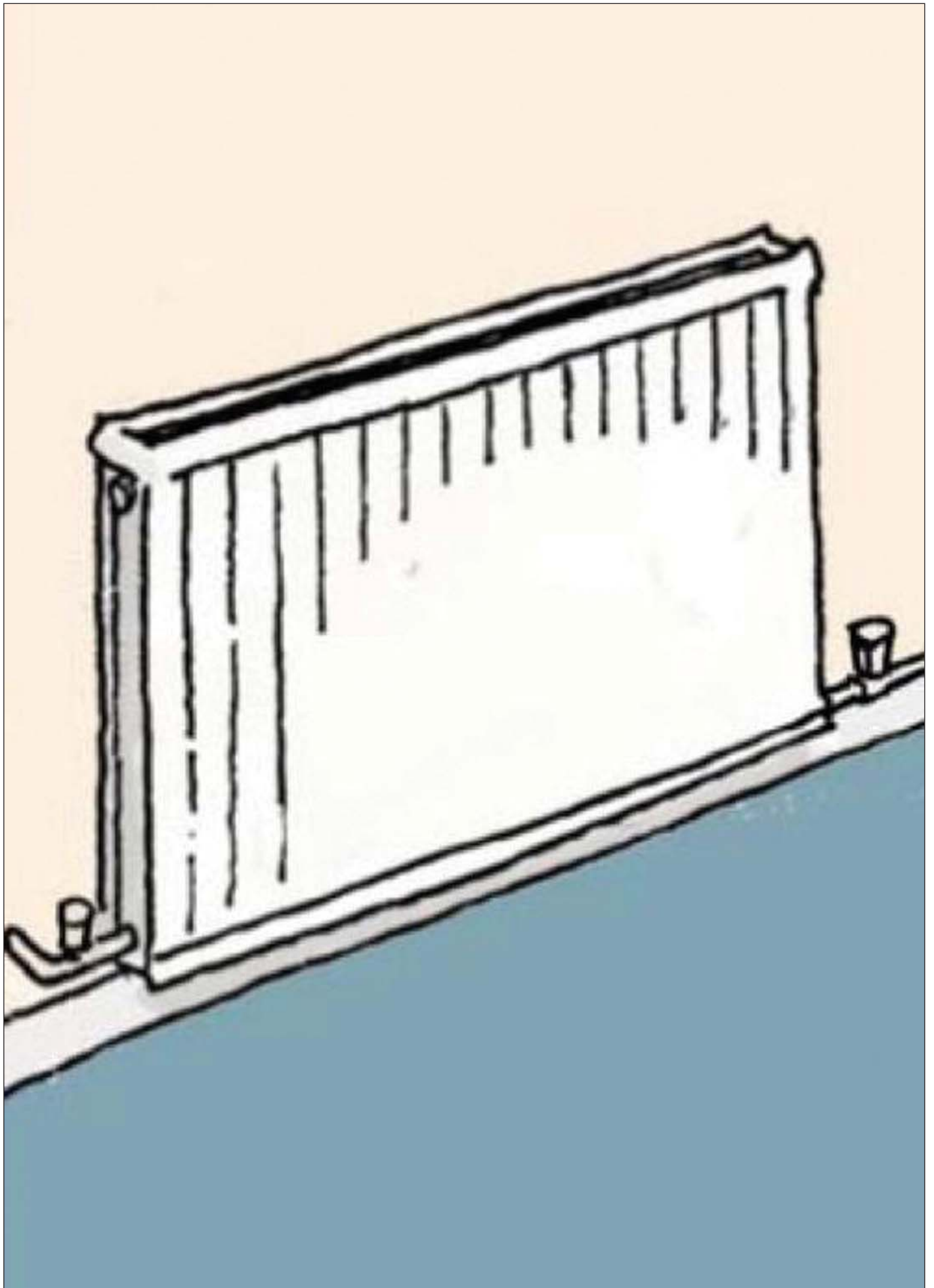
# Mug

- Take care near the radiator as it can burn.



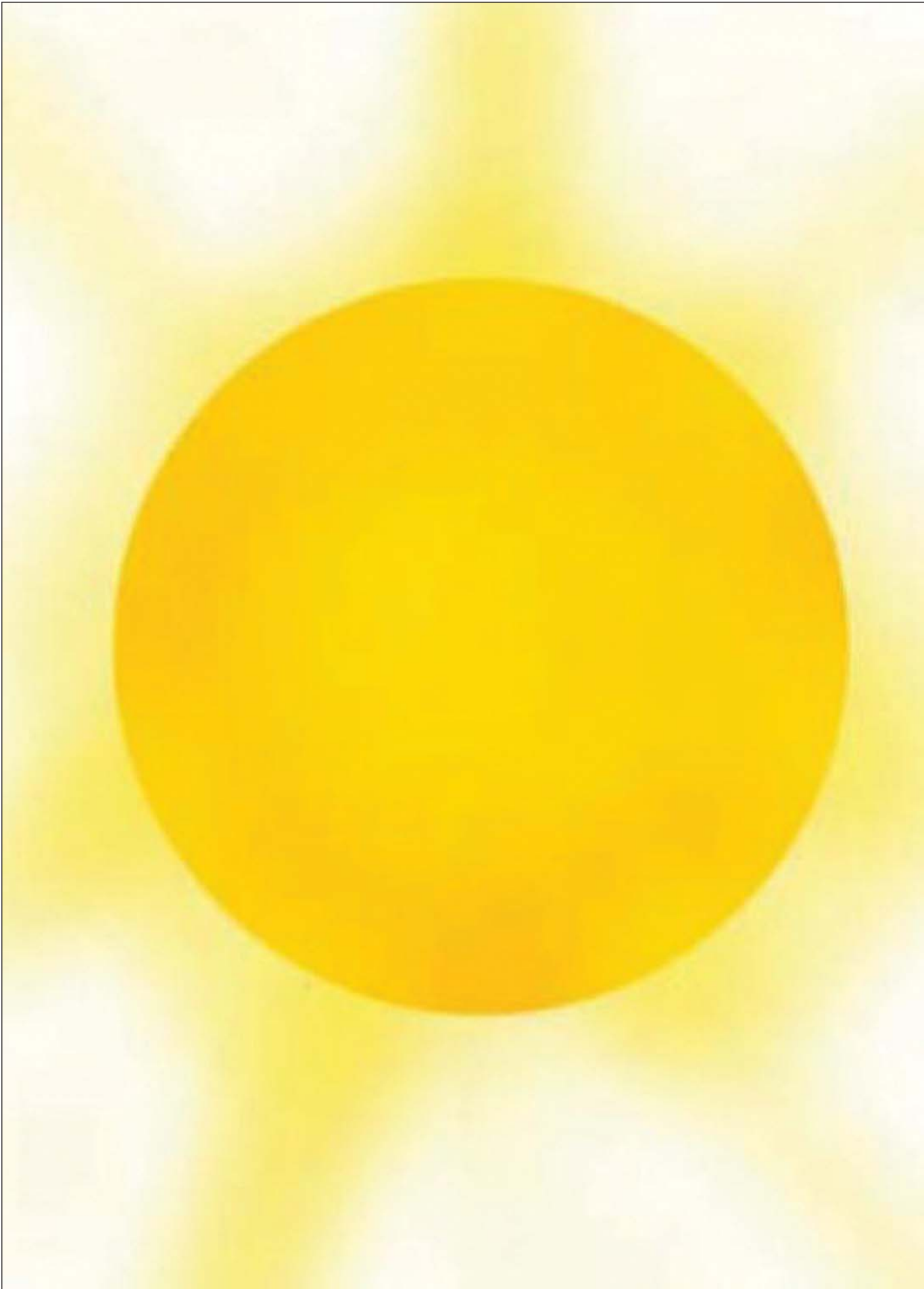
# Snow
